

QUADRANGULAR INTERNATIONALS

There have been four quadrangular internationals in Pitch and Putt history. The first was played in August 1997 at the Glenville club in Dublin. Ireland defeated Canada in the final. Australia were third with England fourth.

Catalonia have dominated the recent quadrangular internationals, which were inaugurated in Galicia at Boiro in 2011. The Catalans have visited the winners' enclosure three times.

France have finished runners-up on two occasions. The Galicians have been third twice while the Basque Country have filled fourth place in 2015 and in 2016.

Galicia will host a quadrangular international for the second time when the four teams (Catalonia, Galicia, France and the Basque Country) congregate at El Pilar Sarria in July 2017.

This year, Eric Puig (Catalonia) will make a record fourth appearance in the Quadrangular International. The former Catalan Strokeplay and Matchplay champion was a member of the winning Catalonia teams in 2011, 2015 and 2016.

Laurent Duffourc will represent France for the third time in the Quadrangular International. Nacho Prada is set to play for Galicia for the third time. For a third occasion Sergio Ipina and Jose Ipina will be in the Basque Country team.

Formats have differed over the years but the record final victory remains Ireland's 9-0 success over the Canadians 20 years ago.
