## PRESENTATION TOURNAMENT WPPT PITCH & PUTT LLEIDA 12<sup>th</sup>- 13<sup>th</sup>- 14<sup>th</sup> November 2021

---

The WPPT is organized by the company World Pitch & Putt Tour S.L.

The WPPT and the FIPPA have a collaboration agreement signed, as well as the FCCP, host of the competition in Catalonia.

### WHO CAN PARTICIPATE

Any player with a current license of a FIPPA member will have the right to play the WPPT Tournament. Each member of the FIPPA will be assigned a certain number of spots, according to the criteria of the FIPPA.

The total number of spots will be 144, distributed as below:

- 10 spots reserved for the WPPT
- 134 spots reserved for affiliated playing members of FIPPA

FIPPA recommends its members to grant the spots based on their own rankings or previous official competitions. It is also recommended to include female players.

FIPPA members should send the final list of selected players to WPPT on Monday, October 25, 2021 the latest.

The official final list of players will be announced on November 1, 2021.

In case that a FIPPA member do not fill all the spots, then the WPPT and FIPPA will fill the available remaining spots according to their own criteria.

## PROVISIONAL PROGRAMME

WPPT players will be able to practice from Monday 11 October until Thursday 11 November, 6:00 PM under the following conditions:

From Monday to Friday: Green fee (18 holes) 10€ / Unlimited daily green fee 15€

Weekends and holidays: Green fee (18 holes) 15€ / Unlimited daily green fee 20€

Unlimited Green fee 71€

The welcome ceremony will take place on Thursday 11 November at 6:00 PM at Pitch & Putt Lleida.

On Friday, November 12, 72 participants will play 36 holes Stroke play, over 2 rounds.

First round: 9.00 AM

Lunch: 12.00 NOON to 1:30h PM

Second round: 2:00 PM

On Saturday, November 13, the other 72 participants will play 36 holes Stroke play, over 2 rounds.

First round: 9.00 AM

Lunch: 12.00 NOON to 1:30h PM

Second round: 2:00 PM

Sunday, November 14 at 11.00 AM, the 36 best ranked participants will play 18 holes Stroke play.

At the end, there will be a prize-giving ceremony and a cocktail aperitif for the 36 finalists, plus 1 player companion.

## RULES

Rules and regulations in accordance with the rules of FIPPA. The competition format will be determined by the Competition Committee.

## REGISTRATIONS

All players must sign up and pay through the WPPT website, [www.worldpitchandputttour.com](http://www.worldpitchandputttour.com), at the time and in the manner indicated. To complete the registration, you will need to fill out a form and explicit acceptance of the regulations and rules of both the FIPPA and the WPPT.

Registration fee will be at 50,00€ that includes:

- 36 holes (Friday or Saturday)
- 1 official tournament t-shirt
- 1 ball of the WPPT
- Accreditation for the VIP player area, that includes breakfast and lunch on Friday or Saturday (depending on the day of play).
- Players who play on Sunday will be issued an accreditation for two people for the VIP player area on Sunday: one for the player and the other for his companion (They must enter together).

## GAME FORMAT

On Friday or Saturday, each player will play 36 holes stroke play. The best 36 players will be qualified to play 18 holes stroke play on Sunday.

The tie will be determined by the best last 18 holes, if the tie still persists, the tie will be determined by the formula of the 9, 12, 15, 17 and 18 best last holes, if the tie still persists, the tie for the last best hole, last two best holes, and so on until the last 36 holes.

In the case of identical cards, all those players for whom a tie cannot be determined will be classified to play on Sunday.

The last holes referred to in this paragraph are the last holes on the course, regardless of the players starting tee.

On Sunday, the best 36 ranked will play 36 holes Stroke play.

### **TEE TIMES**

Starting time will be set by the WPPT in attempt to maintain the player's preferences. The competition will be played on Friday 12, Saturday 13 and Sunday 14 November 2021.

Each player will play 36 holes on the same day, either Friday or Saturday, unless for exceptional reasons the Competition Committee decides to modify it.

The first round on Friday and Saturday will be at 9.00 AM and the second round will be at 2.00 PM.

The best 36 ranked from Friday and Saturday will play 18 holes individual stroke play, starting time at 11:00 AM. The 2 groups with the best ranked players will tee-off with a margin of 6 minutes, from the tee of 1.

### **TIEBREAK**

In the event of a tie for the title, the tied players will play hole by hole to "sudden death" until break the tie, starting on the 18<sup>TH</sup> hole of the course, playing always the same hole.

In the event of a tie for any other place with prize, the formula of the last 18, 36, 54 holes will be applied, if even if the tie persists, the tiebreaker will be determined by the formula of the 9, 12, 15, 17 and 18 best last holes, if the tie still persists, the tiebreaker will be determined by the last best hole, two last holes, and so on until the last 72 best holes. In the case of identical cards, they will be classified in the same position and the prize of the two positions will be distributed at 50%.

The rest will be classified ex-aequo.

The last holes referred to in this paragraph are the last holes on the course, regardless of the players starting tee.

### **PRIZES**

Money prizes before taxes will be as follows:

Regarding the cash prize, the current fiscal tax retention will be applied; For non-residents, the tax applied will be 19,5%, and for legal residents, 15%.

Player's underage of 16, can only receive a "El Corte Ingles" gift voucher.

**WPPT COMMITTEE**

The Organizing Committee will be composed of members of the WPPT.

The suspension of the presentation tournament is responsibility of this committee.

**COMPETITION COMMITTEE**

The Competition Committee will be composed of members of the WPPT.

The Competition Committee may, due to weather conditions or overwhelming force, redefine the competition.

The suspension of the presentation tournament is responsibility of this committee.

The minimum number of holes to play to deliver prizes will be 36 holes.
